

Town of Lincoln, New Hampshire PUBLIC DRINKING ORDINANCE

No person shall drink or consume at any time intoxicating liquor (as defined by N.H. Revised Statues Annotated 21:33) upon any public sidewalk, public street, public park, or public playground, public swimming area, within the Town of Lincoln.

Any person violating the foregoing ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be punished by a fine of not less than fifty dollars (\$50.00) and not more than one hundred dollars (\$100.00) for a first offense and not less of more than one hundred dollars (\$100.00) for each subsequent offense.
